Procedure for the Acquisition of Charcoal Export Licence

- a. An applicant shall submit a signed application letter addressed to the Executive Secretary of the Commission.
- b. Applicants shall fill and submit one original application form signed by a Principal Officer (reference Application Form).
- c. Applicants shall attach receipt confirming the payment of prescribed licence application fee (reference Schedule of Licence Fee).
- d. Applicants shall provide two (2) hard copies and a soft copy (if available) of the above exhibits as separate attachment, clearly labelled and all pages sequentially numbered.
- e. The applicant shall provide the receipt confirming the payment of the Initial Licence fee after the Commission has communicated the Outcome of its Decision on an application to the applicant.

Licence Conditions

The licence holder shall:

- a. comply with the source of wood for the charcoal as indicated in the application;
- b. provide the Commission with receipts of payment made for the feedstock used for the production of charcoal for every export;
- c. submit to the Commission data on quantity of feedstock used for the production of charcoal for every export;
- d. notify the Commission at least 3 working days before the start of every charcoal production;
- e. use fabricated steel or improved kiln for production of charcoal;
- f. comply with the Commission's export quota and schedule;
- g. comply with Forestry Commission and Environmental Protection Agency directives;
- h. grant the Commission and relevant statutory bodies the right of access to inspect the facility;
- i. develop and implement occupational health and safety plans and procedures for its operations and
- j. furnish the Commission within 20 working days of request with details of the licence holder's financial, technical and any other relevant information.
