Welcome to our catalogue on cookstoves and fuels in Ghana. The catalogue contains some cookstoves and cooking fuels found on the market in Accra and Kumasi. The market survey was conducted in Agbogbloshie market, Shoprite (Accra Mall), Marina Mall, and Melcom (Spintex) in Accra, and Roman Hill, and Suame Magazine in Kumasi. The data was collected in March 2023.

The prices for cookstoves and fuels were recorded during the catalogue survey in March 2023 and may be subject to change.

The technologies showcased are solid biomass (charcoal, firewood, sawdust, pellet), ethanol, and LPG cookstoves. The fuels are mainly carbonised briquettes produced from agricultural waste. It consist of products that are either locally produced or imported.

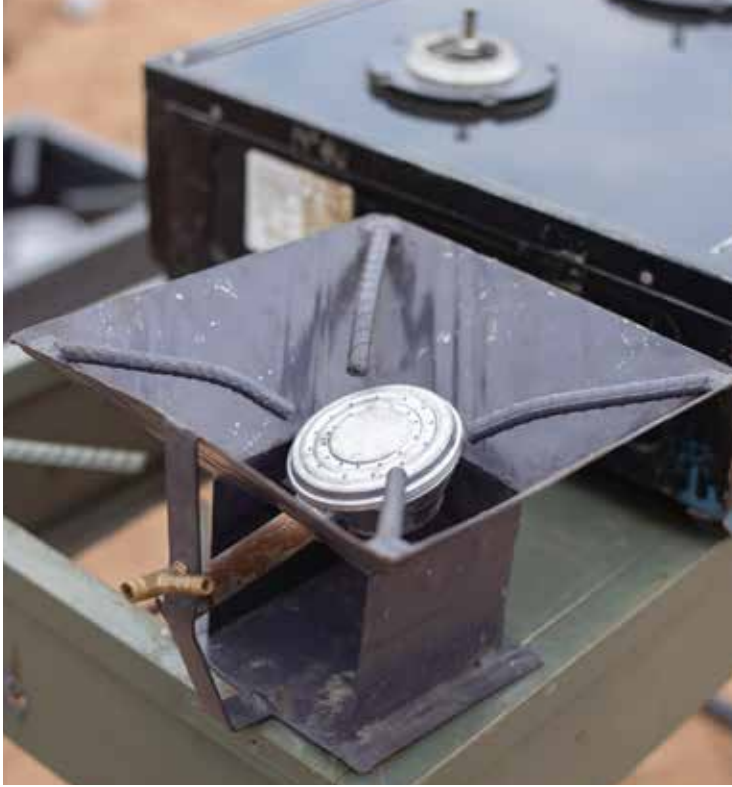

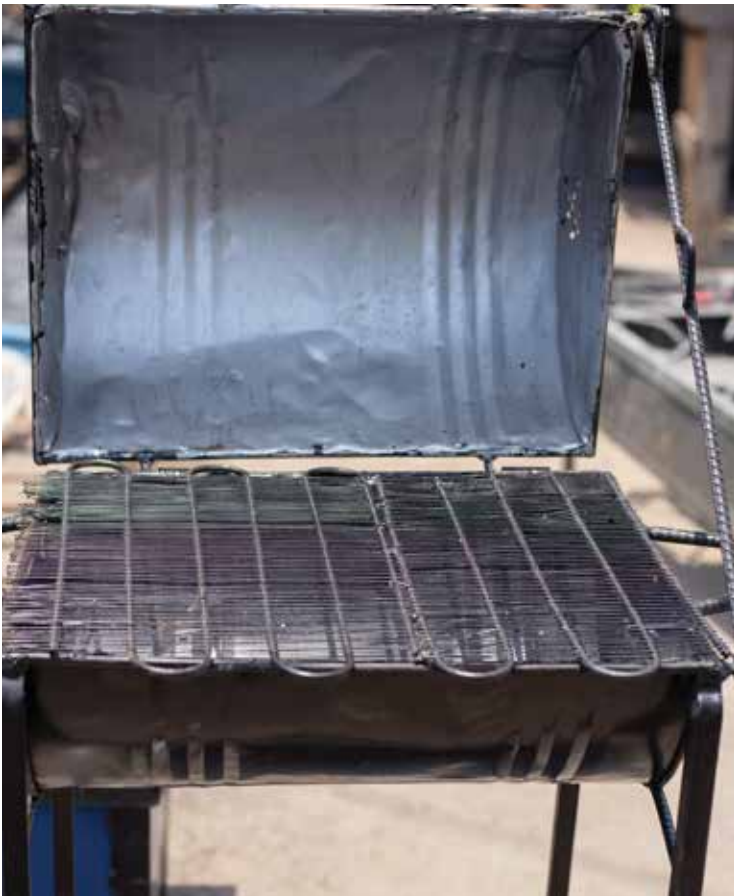

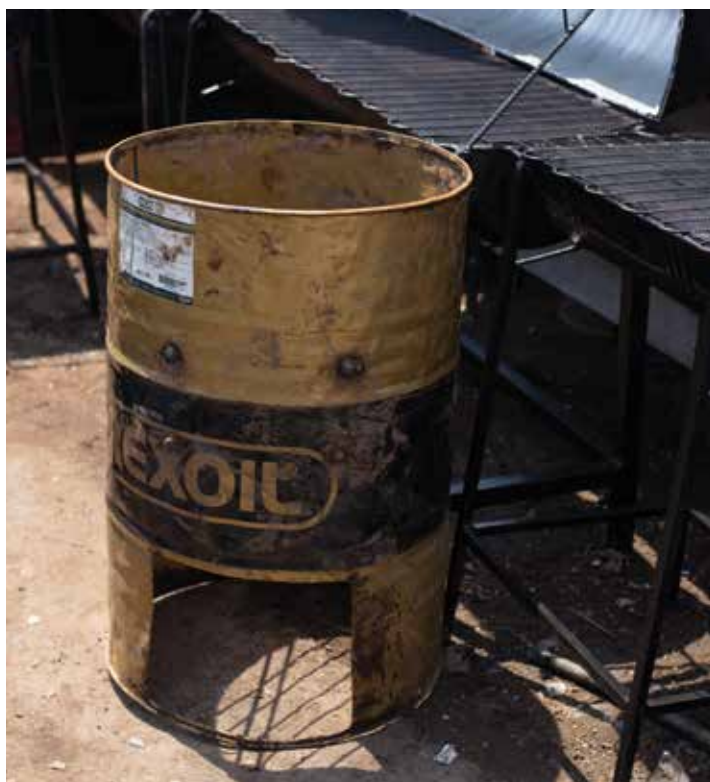
